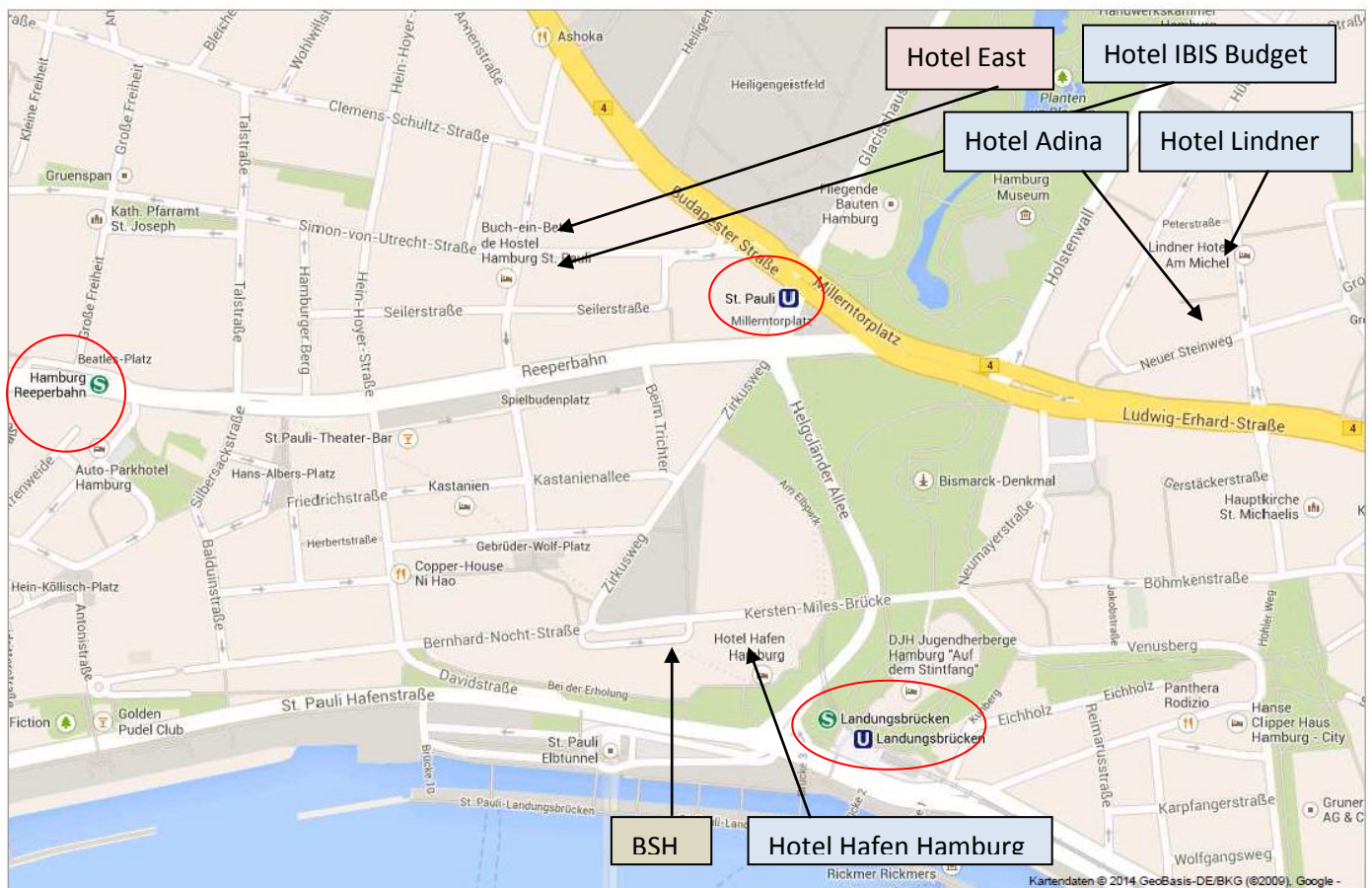

From the Hamburg Airport:

By public transport: direct connection from Airport Station by local train (S-Bahn) No 1 to
“Landungsbrücken” or “Reeperbahn”

From main train station (Hauptbahnhof) also by underground (U-Bahn) No 3 to
“Landungsbrücken” or “St. Pauli”

By taxi – journey time from the airport about 20 minutes (average price ca. 28 - 30 €)
